

What is UKIYO-E?

Traditional woodcut print making is a composite art form in which the individual, specialist skills of artists, wood carvers and print makers are combined to create a delicate and beautiful work of art known as Ukiyo-e (pictures of the modern world). The world of woodcut printmaking is one of grace and warmth that is not found in any other form of printing. Through the skillful hands of master craftsmen of the Heisei era, this traditional art form has been inherited by the current age.

The Adachi Foundation for the Preservation of Woodcut Printing

Japanese traditional woodcut printing is a very unique and original printing method. However the number of the artisans skilled in the technique of woodcut printing is decreasing. The Adachi Foundation for the Preservation of Woodcut Printing was established in 1994 in order to preserve and pass on these skills to future generations.



13 minute walk from Shibuya Station

■ Take the city bus from bus stop 54 at the Shibuya Station East Exit Bus Terminal. The bus is marked "Gaku 03, Red Cross Medical Center" (学03日赤医療センター行)Get off the bust at the stop for Kokugakuin University(国学院大学前)

15 minute walk from Omotesando station (Take Exit B1)

From Ebisu

↑ 15 minute walk from Ebisu station

■ City Bus: from Ebisu Station West Exit Rotary Bust stop 1, take the bus marked Gaku 06 Red Cross Medical Ceter (学03日赤医療センター行) and get off at Higashi Yon Chome (東四丁目)
